M., Tuesday June 28, 2022 for furnishing a minimum of 20,000 tons of aggregate (gravel) material and 10,000 cubic yards of associated ice control sand, or such lesser quantities as the bidder may be willing and able to supply prior to September 1, 2022. Material shall meet current MCRC Standard Specifications, see attached.

# MASON COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION PROCESSED AGGREGATE (GRAVEL) SPECIFICATIONS

### Description

This material shall be used for aggregate surfacing, patching and for aggregate base material under a hard surfacing. It is intended that this material shall be available for a period of at least one (1) year and possible multiple years.

The material may be delivered to the yard of the Mason County Road Commission, depending on the cost of hauling, or pickup by the MCRC at the Bidders yard.

#### 22A-Modified Materials

This material shall be processed, well graded, and homogenous material. It shall consist of clean, hard, durable, course aggregate, free from clay lumps and soft or flaky material and shall conform to the following gradation. Any deviation of this gradation shall only be accepted if approved in writing by the Mason County Road Commission.

### 22A Materials

This material shall be processed, well graded, and homogenous material. It shall consist of clean, hard, durable, course aggregate, free from clay lumps and soft or flaky material and shall conform to the following gradation. Any deviation of this gradation shall only be accepted if approved in writing by the Mason County Road Commission.

#### 2NS – Ice Control Sand

This material shall be processed, well graded, and homogenous material. The below gradation represents the target gradation for 2NS material. The 3/8, No.4 & No.8 sieve must follow the below requirements. The remaining sieves may vary depending on the quality of the materials excavated from the pit.

# **Stockpile**

Stockpile in the Bidders yard shall be secured in an area protected by a gate or fence or other means acceptable by the Mason County Road Commission. The Road Commission shall provide its own means for loading trucks. Stockpile must be available for one (1) to two (2) construction seasons depending on size and/or location of the pile.

## **Delivery of Materials**

If MCRC elects to have material delivered to their yard:

- Delivery of materials may be over an extended period of time, not to exceed one (1) year.
- Scheduling of deliveries shall be as ordered by MCRC. Upon receipt of order, the successful Bidder(s) shall commence delivery within twenty-four (24) hours.

#### **Testing**

Aggregate (Gravel) gradation testing with passing results and Ice Control Sand gradation test results shall be provided by the Bidder(s) prior to final payment. MCRC reserves the right to do periodic independent assurance testing. Material determined to be not in compliance with the gradation may be rejected. Testing frequency shall be one (1) test for each 1,000 cubic yards or 1,500 tons.

## Measurement and Payment

Measurement for material stockpiled in the supplier's yard shall be by **Cubic Yard**. The supplier shall certify to the amount present and guarantee amount. The MCRC reserves the right to do periodic stockpile cross sections to verify amounts.

Measurement of material delivered to the MCRC property in Scottville shall be by the **Ton** with the supplier to provide weight tickets from a certified scale for each load.

Payment shall be based on the unit price quoted by the ton or cubic yard whichever is bid and shall include all labor, equipment, and miscellaneous other costs to provide the material. No other additions shall be considered in the unit price.

Payment for material either stockpiled or delivered shall be over a <u>minimum</u> period of twelve (12) months - as agreed to by the Mason County Road Commission and the Contractor - beginning the first month after award, then continuing until the amount is paid off.
