## Why lakes, ponds & streams need aquatic plants

Univ. of Minnesota Bulletin FO-06955

- ➔ Aquatic plants are beneficial in many ways. Areas with aquatic vegetation produce more food items for fish, such as insect larvae, snails, and other invertebrates. Aquatic vegetation offers shelter and spawning habitat for fish.
- ➔ Many emergent plants provide food for waterfowl and habitat for insects on which some waterfowl feed. Aquatic plants further benefit lakes by producing oxygen and by absorbing phosphorus and nitrogen from runoff. Emergent
- ➔ By examining the stream margin, pond edge or lakeshore before you buy property, you can often tell how abundant native aquatic plants will be. A muddy shoreline is a result of the wave action on the lake's substrates. It is not true that if you remove vegetation a sandy beach will appear. Removing vegetation will create more mobile soils resulting in murkiness and turbidity.
- ➔ After property development, shorelines may need to be restored with appropriate vegetation to keep the water clear. Restoration projects increase the diversity of native plants, stabilize sediments by using plants with both deep & shallow roots, and slow runoff into a water body.
